

# Make a difference in your library– Join the Teen Advisory Group!

The **Lewisville Public Library Teen Advisory Group (TAG)** is a group of engaged and enthusiastic teens ages 13 to 18 from the local area, who meet monthly and work together and with Library staff to make LPL a better place for all area teens. Being active in TAG is a great way to develop leadership and planning skills, and to meet other service-minded teens.

Examples of things TAG teens do...

- Publicize Teen programs and events
- Plan and lead Teen and Youth programs and events
- Act as a liaison between school librarians and the Library's staff
- Provide input on new/changing policies and services that affect teens
- Recommend materials to improve the Teen book and media collections
- Help keep Teen Point clean and attractive
- Recruit interested teens to join TAG
- Represent the Library at community events
- HAVE FUN!

If you want to see what TAG's all about before joining, feel free to join us at our next meeting; no registration is required, just show up!

Please fill out the attached **application** yourself and have your parent complete the **Parent Agreement Form**, then return both items to the Youth Services Desk in the Children's Wing on the 1st floor. Once you do that, you may attend TAG Meetings regularly. (You may detach and keep this informational page.)

<u>Please note</u>: Though you may start attending TAG Meetings regularly once your paperwork is turned in, there is a three month/meeting probationary period before you become a full member.

#### Frequently asked questions:

#### Do I have to be a resident of Lewisville or have an LPL library card to join TAG?

Nope, you just have to be interested in making LPL and the city of Lewisville a better place for all area teens. Many of our past members have lived in nearby communities.

#### Why is there a probationary period?

Our TAG must make plans and commitments months in advance when planning programs, exploring local volunteer opportunities, etc., so we need to be sure that prospective members are committed to attending meetings/events and being active in the group. The probationary period also gives the TAG mentors time to help you become more comfortable in the group, if needed, and it gives you more time to see if TAG is a good fit for you.

# What if I have seasonal commitments like sports or marching band so I can't commit to being active in TAG every month, but I am still interested in joining and being active in TAG when I'm not involved in those things?

Reach out to a TAG Mentor before or after a meeting, or via phone or email (contact information is below), so we can learn more about your particular situation. We can usually come up with ways to keep you informed and engaged in TAG while your focus is on those seasonal activities, so that you can jump right in and be active in TAG on months when you are able to attend meetings and events.

#### What are some perks of being a TAG member?

- Earn a TAG t-shirt by attending three meetings and signing up to participate in an event

- Earn a limited number of Library volunteer hours (teens ages 14-18 only, per City volunteer rules)\*

- Get access to Advance Reader's Copies (ARCs) of new and upcoming teen books (when available)

- TAG Mentors may be able to write letters of recommendation and/or be a reference for you for college and scholarship applications, scouting awards, jobs, and more

\*Please note: TAG is not intended to be a main source of volunteer hours for teens needing hours for school, church, clubs, etc.; they are offered as a way of thanking our members for their service to the Library. Teens looking for a large number of hours should explore our Teen Volunteer Program (details on our website, <u>library.cityoflewisville.com</u>, or ask at the Youth Services Desk).
